




Offering an objection to a position is called offering a "defeater."


The response in countering the defeater is called a "defeater defeater."


Note, however, that defeating a defeater does not prove the original position is true.

This would just show that, if the original position is false, it would be for reasons other than the defeater. Part of defending the truth of a position is showing that the position is internally consistent (i.e., showing that the position is not internally inconsistent).


Note, however, that showing that the position is internally consistent, is not the same as showing that the position is true.






























Revelation is God making known to mankind His divine person and divine truths that would otherwise be unknown; to unveil

God making known to mankind His divine person and divine truths that would otherwise be unknown


Revelation is giving of the truth.


God transferring His divine truths to mankind through human agency into written language form for mankind to understand Inspiration is the recording of the truth.






Special Revelation is God making known to mankind through His prophets, apostles, and His Son of His nature and will that could not be known through General Revelation.



















Christ saves not only those who consciously believe the gospel, but also all who never heard the gospel but fulfilled other requirements (e.g., responded to what they knew)






All religions can lead to God.

be actually saved.








Also called Particularism,

believing the gospel) are condemned.


The Case for Exclusivism

Jesus taught that He was the only way.




Jesus taught that He was the only way.

The apostles taught that Jesus was the only way.




One has eternal life by believing on Jesus.



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General Revelation

Given through creation (Creation is known through simple apprehension)

Reveals God's existence and attributes

Given TO all people

All people have it

Some accept, some reject

Sufficient to condemn if rejected

Acceptance is necessary but not sufficient for eternal life

Special Revelation

Given through Prophets (Prophets are read by their Scripture)

Reveals God's gospel and will

Given FOR all people

Not all people have it

Some accept, some reject

Sufficient to save if accepted

Acceptance is necessary and sufficient for eternal life
