

Free Grace


persevere therein to the end








There are important difference between the doctrine I will be defending here and the Calvinist (Reformed) doctrine of perseverance of the saints.

The Reformed doctrine denies that the Christian can lose eternal life. But it goes further and maintains that a Christian can fall away only to a certain limit in this life.


What the Doctrine Does Not Mean

"Not everyone who says to Me, 'Lord, Lord,' shall enter the kingdom of heaven, but he who does the will of My Father in heaven. {22} Many will say to Me in that day, 'Lord, Lord, have we not prophesied in Your name, cast out demons in Your name, and done many wonders in Your name?' {23} And then I will declare to them, 'I never knew you; depart from Me, you who practice lawlessness!"





PERISH It is not God's will that we perish.

"What do you think? If a man has a hundred sheep, and one of them goes astray, does he not leave the ninety-nine and go to the mountains to seek the one that is straying? {13} And if he should find it, assuredly, I say to you, he rejoices more over that sheep than over the ninety-nine that did not go astray. {14} Even so it is not the will of your Father who is in heaven that one of these little ones should perish."



∽ John 6:37-39 ≪

"All that the Father gives Me will come to Me, and the one who comes to Me I will by no means cast out. {38} For I have come down from heaven, not to do My own will, but the will of Him who sent Me. {39} This is the will of the Father who sent Me, that of all He has given Me I should lose nothing, but should raise it up at the last day."



PRAYER Jesus prayed for us.

"I do not pray that You should take them out of the world, but that You should keep them from the evil one. ... {20} I do not pray for these alone, but also for those who will believe in Me through their word;"



So POWER Solution God is powerful: Nothing can separate us (from without).


Beloved, now we are children of God; and it has not yet been revealed what we shall be, but we know that when He is revealed, we shall be like Him, for we shall see Him as He is.

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In Him you also trusted, after you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation; in whom also, having believed, you were sealed with the Holy Spirit of promise,






PROMISE The Spirit is an earnest or guarantee.

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
Therefore He is also able to save to the uttermost those who come to God through Him, since He ever lives to make intercession for them.



- 1. Interpret obscure passages in light of clear.
- 2. Interpret minority passages in light of majority.
- 3. Interpret earlier revelation in light of later revelation.

Dealing with "Problem" Verses in General on Eternal Security


- 1. Is the passage referring to one who has lost his salvation or to one who was never saved in the first place?
- The word 'saved' does not always necessarily refer to going to heaven when one dies, but may refer to temporal deliverance. (Matt. 8:24-25)

∽ Matthew 8:24-25 ~

And suddenly a great tempest arose on the sea, so that the boat was covered with the waves. But He was asleep. {25} Then His disciples came to Him and awoke Him, saying, "Lord, save us! We are perishing!"



 The word 'judgment' does not necessarily refer to going to hell when one dies, but may refer to temporal judgment. (Rom. 14:10; 2 Cor. 5:10; 1 Cor. 11:28-30; James 3:1; 1 Peter 4:17)

For we must all appear before the judgment seat of Christ, that each one may receive the things done in the body, according to what he has done, whether good or bad.



Solution 10:28-30

But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup. {29} For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. {30} For this reason many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep.

 What does the Bible say happens to a Christian when he sins? (Heb. 12:7-11. 1 Cor. 11:27-31)

∽ Hebrews 12:7-11 ~

If you endure chastening, God deals with you as with sons; for what son is there whom a father does not chasten? {8} But if you are without chastening, of which all have become partakers, then you are illegitimate and not sons. {9} Furthermore, we have had human fathers who corrected us, and we paid them respect. Shall we not much more readily be in subjection to the Father of spirits and live? {10} For they indeed for a few days chastened us as seemed best to them, but He for our profit, that we may be partakers of His holiness. {11} Now no chastening seems to be joyful for the present, but painful; nevertheless, afterward it yields the peaceable fruit of righteousness to those who have been trained by it.



9 1 Corinthians 11:27-31 🛩

Therefore whoever eats this bread or drinks this cup of the Lord in an unworthy manner will be guilty of the body and blood of the Lord. {28} But let a man examine himself, and so let him eat of the bread and drink of the cup. {29} For he who eats and drinks in an unworthy manner eats and drinks judgment to himself, not discerning the Lord's body. {30} For this reason many are weak and sick among you, and many sleep. {31} For if we would judge ourselves, we would not be judged.

For it is impossible for those who were once enlightened, and have tasted the heavenly gift, and have become partakers of the Holy Spirit, {5} and have tasted the good word of God and the powers of the age to come, {6} if they fall away, to renew them again to repentance, since they crucify again for themselves the Son of God, and put Him to an open shame. {7}For the earth which drinks in the rain that often comes upon it, and bears herbs useful for those by whom it is cultivated, receives blessing from God; {8} but if it bears thorns and briars, it is rejected and near to being cursed, whose end is to be burned.


You have become estranged from Christ, you who attempt to be justified by law; you have fallen from grace.



Solution Series Series Series 10:26-30

For if we sin willfully after we have received the knowledge of the truth, there no longer remains a sacrifice for sins, {27} but a certain fearful expectation of judgment, and fiery indignation which will devour the adversaries. {28} Anyone who has rejected Moses' law dies without mercy on the testimony of two or three witnesses. {29} Of how much worse punishment, do you suppose, will he be thought worthy who has trampled the Son of God underfoot, counted the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified a common thing, and insulted the Spirit of grace? {30} For we know Him who said, "Vengeance is Mine; I will repay, says the Lord." And again, "The LORD will judge His people."





∽ Matthew 12:31-32 ~

"Therefore I say to you, every sin and blasphemy will be forgiven men, but the blasphemy against the Spirit will not be forgiven men. "Anyone who speaks a word against the Son of Man, it will be forgiven him; but whoever speaks against the Holy Spirit, it will not be forgiven him, either in this age or in the age to come.
