The Time of the End. Thy Kingdom Come. (God's unwitting agency), as clearly shown in Revelation. This Time of the End, or day of Jehovah's preparation, beginning A. D. 1799 and closing A. D. 1914, though characterized by a great increase of knowledge over all past ages, until in 1870 all temporal authority of the popes again ceased—we believe never to be revived. Remember, too, that it was Napoleon's soldiers who broke open the Inquithat it was Napoleon's soldiers who broke open the Inquisitions, and put an end to public tortures and executions for religious convictions.

The effect of the partial breaking down of priest-craft and superstition, while it has led to more open infidelity, has also, in thus overthrowing a superstitious reverence for men, led to more intelligent thought on the part of the consecrated people of God—many of whom previously scarcely dared to think, or study the Scriptures for themselves. 





Certain reasonable obstacles to faith in Christ's presence might yet appear to the minds of even careful students, and we wish to see these all removed. For instance, it might reasonably be inquired, How is it that the exact Bible Chronology points to October 1872 as the beginning of the seventh thousand years, or Millennium, while the Jubilee Cycles show October 1874 to be the date of our Lord's return and the beginning of restitution times? This apparent inharmony of the date of the second ad-

This apparent inharmony of the date of the second advent with the beginning of the seventh thousand years seemed at first sight to indicate "a screw loose" somewhere in the chronological reckoning, and led to careful re-examination of the subject, but always with the same result. Closer thought, however, proves that God is an exact time-keeper, and that this point is no exception to his mathematical precision. It will be remembered that the reckoning of chronology began with the creation of Adam, and that some time was spent by Adam and Eve before sin entered. Just how long we are not informed, but two years would not be an improbable estimate. Before the creation of Eve, Adam was permitted to live long enough to realize his lack of a companion (Gen. 2:20); he had become acquainted with and had named all the animals; he had become acquainted with the various trees and plants of Eden.

7 In addition to helping others believe the Bible, we ourselves need to take time to read it regularly. Are you doing that? Of all the books ever produced, this one is the most important. Of course, this does not mean that if we read it on our own, we need nothing else. The Scriptures warn against isolating ourselves. We should not think that we can figure out everything by independent research. Both personal study and regular attendance at the meetings of God's people are needed if we are to be balanced Christians.—Proverbs 18:1; Hebrews 10:24.25.

8 Regarding this, the Bible tells about an Ethiopian official who was reading from the prophecy of Isaiah. An angel directed the Christian evangelizer Philip to ask the man: "Do you actually know what you are reading?" Humbly, the Ethiopian replied: "Really, how could I ever do so, unless someone guided me?" He urged Philip to explain the passage of Scripture. Now, Philip was not merely an independent Bible reader who gave his opinion on the Scriptures. He maintained close contact with God's visible organization. So he could help the Ethiopian to benefit from the instruction that Jehovah was making available through that organization. Keep a Firm Grip on the Word of God

⁹ To help us understand the Bible, Jehovah's organization supplies excellent Scriptural material in various publications. In addition, a regular schedule of Bible reading is set out for us in connection with the Theocratic Ministry School held in all the congregations of Jehovah's Witnesses throughout the world. Great benefit can come from personally examining the Holy Scriptures. (Psalm 1:1-3; 19-7, 8) Make a special effort to read the Bible regularly. Even though you do not fully understand everything, your getting an overall view of the Scriptures will be of great value. For example, if you read only four or five pages a day, you can complete the Bible in about a year.

10 When can you do your Bible reading? If you set aside even 10 or 15 minutes a day for it, you will be greatly benefited. If not, at least schedule regular times for it each week, and then hold to that schedule. If you are married, you and your mate can enjoy reading the Bible aloud to each other. If there are children old enough to read, they may take turns reading aloud. Bible reading should be a lifelong habit, like eating food. As you know, if a person's eating habits are poor, his health will suffer. So, too, our spiritual life, and hence our eternal life, depends on our being regularly nourished on "every utterance coming forth through Jehovah's mouth."—Matthew 4:4.



How vital is it to know the truth? Many religions today, while claiming to follow the Bible, are largely influenced by human philosophies and traditions. Often, religious leaders seem not as concerned with the accuracy of their message as they are with its acceptance by the masses. Some feel that God is satisfied with any form of worship,

as long as it is sincere. But Jesus Christ explained: "The hour is coming, and it is now, when the true worshipers will worship the Father with spirit and truth, for, indeed, the Father is looking for suchlike ones to worship him." —John 4:23.

If we want to worship God acceptably, we must know the truth This is an important issue. Our eternal happiness depends on it. Therefore, everyone should ask himself: 'Is my way of worship acceptable to God? Am I genninely interested in learning the truth of God's Word? Or am I afraid of what a careful investigation might reveal?'

But this meant that most of my prior be-liefs were wrong. My family, my friends, people whom lleved—they were all wrong, was nervous. I kept saking myself how my family would react to what I had newly dis-covered. As time passed and with Jehovah's help, I began to adjust to this overwhelm-ing experience. One day I decided to confide in a family friend, a professor of theology. I told him all about my desire to find the truth. Then he noted, 'If you want to know the truth, look for Jehovah's Witnesses.'" As Eugenia had feared, her family put her out of the house. The Witnesses, how-ever, continued to give her spiritual help. She comments: "I was strengthened to take

a stand for the truth. I realized that it was something worth fighting for. The welcome I received from Jehovah's Witnesses was so important. I felt lowed within the Christian congregation. Getting close to God's organization helped me to overcome the fear of having to stand alone."

Consider another example. Sabrina grew up accustomed to having regular family discussions about the Bible. In fact, they developed a form of 'family religion.' She made it a practice to associate with members of various religions to expose their errors. When one of Jehovah's Witnesses offered her a Bible study, she readily accepted with the intention of disproving their beliefs.

WORSHIPING GOD WITH TRUTH

For worship to be acceptable to God, it must be based on truth. (John 4:23) The Bible identifies true worshipers as belonging to "the congregation of the living God, a pillar and support of the truth." (1 Timothy 3:15) The ones making up the congregation of God not only believe the truth of God's Word but also live in harmony with it and defend it, making it known throughout the earth.

who have conducted their own personal in vestigation of the teachings of Jehovah's Witnesses have benefited greatly.


Knowledge of the Truth Dispels Fear
